## Adelaide Botanic Garden

Established over 150 years ago, this green haven in the heart of the city features fascinating plant collections, a beautifully restored Victorian-era glasshouse, the new SA Water Mediterranean Garden and Amazon Waterlily Pavilion, a restaurant, bookshop and the magnificent Bicentennial Conservatory.

*Free Guided Walks from the Schomburgk Pavilion at 10.30 am every day (except Good Friday and Christmas Day). Walking access from city via North Terrace Gates.*



## Mt Lofty Botanic Garden

100 hectares of native bush, blended with lush gullies of exotic plants from the cool temperate regions of the world. Marvel at the specialised collections in Fern Gully, Rhododendron Gully, Magnolia Gully, New Zealand Gully, South American Gully and many others. The autumn displays are breathtaking.

*Free Guided Walks from the Lower Car Park, Lampert Rd, Piccadilly. These walks are held at 10.30am on Thursdays. Please wear good walking shoes.*



## Wittunga Botanic Garden

An historic garden, featuring South Australia's largest collection of South African plants and a fine representation of colourful Australian natives. A wonderfully peaceful place to explore the botanical connections between these two continents.

*Free Guided Walks from the car park, Shepherds Hill Rd, Blackwood, 10.30 am every Tuesday - beginning of August to end of November.*
